Step 1	Explore family stories.	Read two stories starring families. Read book reviews online to help find interesting stories that would interest you and your family.	Watch a family story. Step 2	Know where your family is from.	Ask about a festival, holiday, or event. Talk to a family member about why this event is special.	Ask about a song, game, or dance. Try to sing the song, play the game, or dance the dance! You could teach it to your siblings or another family member.	Ask about a family recipe. Ask a family member to help you make a family recipe.
Step 3	Make a story tree.	Look online at Brownie Elf's Story tree, and then fill-in the My Story Tree with your family's info.	Draw or paint your very own family tree.	Create a family tree using the computer or an online website.
Step 4	Find an object that means something to your family.	Ask to look at old family photo albums and learn more about your family's history.	Talk about an object that has been handed down within your family.	Ask about an object that belongs to a faraway family member.
Step 5	Share your family story.	Have a "family tree" virtual potluck party. Share family recipes by email with your Brownie troop.	Make a family crest. Think of what is important to your family, and then draw your own crest.	Become pen pals with another member of your family.
